DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story frame structure is located on Mountain Road. It is covered with asbestos siding. The house faces northeast.

The dwelling is three bays by two (on the first elevation) with a center door. The original front door has been removed and now appears in the entrance of the glass enclosed, one story, hip roofed, porch on this dwelling's principal facade. This door is paneled and has floral ornamentation. Windows through most of the house are one over one modern replacements. Shutters on the northeast facade's windows and the first elevation of each of the other three facades are non-functional replacements though some of the old hardware still remains.

The house has a gable flank roof, covered with asphalt shingles. The roof was originally covered with wood shingles. The roof has wide eaves and brick chimneys at each inside gable end. A two story addition on the south has a chimney at its gable end as well.

Inside, some beaded door trim remains though most of the interior is altered. No fireplaces remain. Upstairs the floors consist of wide wood planks joined with square nails.

The cellar walls are rubblestone and have windows. Rough hewn logs are visible in the ceiling. A buttress is present.

Water for this house is provided by a hand dug, stone lined, well in the yard.


