DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Crowther house is a large coursed rubble stone structure of two storeys under a gable roof (ridge east-west) of moderate pitch. The facade (south elevation) is of three bays, a single door with narrow sidelights and a large transom as the entrance in the easternmost bay, up a short flight of stone steps. There is a single basement window on this elevation. Fenestration in the west gable end consists of two bays grouped centrally on both storeys and in the attic. There is a two bay addition at the west end of the north elevation, of two smaller storeys, with a gable roof at right angles to the main roof, its ridge just reaching the eaves of the main roof. The upper storey is accessible only through a separate entrance at the north gable end. The masonry is articulated by heavy dressed coars and granite sills and lintels. The seam in the masonry between the wing and the main block is easily discernible. There are iron "S" bolts at the attic floor level on both east and west gable ends. The north and south walls are finished with several courses of brick, concealed by boxed eaves. Windows are 6/6.

On the interior, the plan is largely intact, but details have been sacrificed. Large double parlor doors, hinged, were removed to unite the two downstairs rooms, and the fireplaces have been altered. The stair is a simple 1850's design and remains intact. The house was built over a spring, which still exists in the basement within a 7-foot diameter stone ring (dairy). The lower storey of the addition is accessible from the north room of the main block, and is used as a kitchen.




