**Description of Property and Eligibility Determination:** *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The property was most recently observed and photographed on January 17, 2003. Its condition was unchanged since the preparation of the Inventory Form for State Historic Sites Survey form in the library of the Maryland Historical Trust.

The property is described in the Maryland Historical Trust Inventory Form For State Historic Sites Survey prepared by Natalie Shivers, Harford County Historical District Commission, in May 1979. Following is a brief summary of that property description, as modified by site observations made January 17, 2003.

From the description, the house is a two story "T" shaped, gabled roofed (east to west), stone house, which is five bays wide and one room deep with chimneys at each end. The exterior chimney on the east is replaced and the interior chimney on the west is original. The south side has the main entrance and the west end has entrance wood porticos/porch. Fenestration is typically 6/6 sash windows with wood and stone

lintels. In addition, the house was originally described as being in excellent condition and altered. Presently, the property is in a somewhat deteriorated state, externally, requiring painting and other repairs.

The house has no apparent association with historic events or personages that would qualify it for registration under Criteria A or B, respectively. Its design is utilitarian and undistinguished architecturally. Therefore, the building does not meet the requirements of Criterion C for Design/Construction. No known archaeological significance is attached to the property, eliminating it from eligibility under Criterion D.




De Swan-Lillie House  
North side of Churchville Road  
Aberdeen, Maryland 21001

This two-story clapboard house with a gable roof was given by Christopher De Swan to his daughter, Mary E. Lillie, in 1892. It was part of the property called "Anns and Margareths Purchase" he had purchased from William Carsins in 1866. The house may have been built before he subdivided the property for his children: the 1878 Martenet's Map shows a building in approximately this location.

Captain De Swan had the first blacksmith trade in Carsins Run. His shop was located at the crossroads of Churchville Road and Carsins Run road. He had two sons and three daughters and provided houses for each of his three daughters in this area.

**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This two-story gable-roofed frame house covered in clapboards is located on the north side of Churchville Road (RTE. 22) at Carsins Run. A standard late 19th century house—three bays wide and one room deep—with interior end brick chimneys, it has two additions: on the west is a one-story shed-roofed wing with a tall exterior brick chimney; to the north of it is another one-story, shed-roofed wing—this one covered in vertical boards.

Set on a high stone foundation, which is stuccoed in some places, the main house faces east and has a boxed cornice and a three-bay shed-roofed porch across the front. Most windows have 6/6 sash and louvered shutters; the gable windows have four lights.

With three windows in the second story and a central entrance flanked by a window on each side in the first story, the east facade has a recent shingled basement addition under the porch. The porch has carved balusters and brackets and is reached from the south by a flight of stone steps.

The north end is blank except for two gable windows. The south end has two windows in each story. The west side is covered mostly by the one-story wing, but, like the east side, has three windows in the second story. In the first story south bay is an entrance with a shed-roofed portico.

**STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

This house was given by Christopher De Swan to his daughter Mary E. Lillie in 1892.<sup>1</sup> It was part of the property he had obtained from William Carsins in 1866, paying \$1000 for 8 acres of "Anns and Margareths Purchase".<sup>2</sup> It is not clear whether the house was built before or after De Swan subdivided the lot into parcels for his children. However, the 1878 Martenet's Map shows a building in approximately this location, (attributed to William Carsin). The 1858 Herrick's Map shows no building here.

According to one source, "Captain" De Swan had the first blacksmith trade in Carsins Run. (His shop was at the crossroads of Churchville Road and Carsins Run Road.) He had three sons and two daughters and, except for the two sons who left the area, gave each of his children a house on his land. He himself lived with his unmarried daughter, Augusta, in the back of the De Swan-Mahan house (HA \_\_\_\_\_), which he had given to another daughter, Amanda I. Gorrell.<sup>3</sup>

Shuttered windows have 6 lights over 6. A one story porch across the south side of the house has an enclosed tool-room below. The porch railing and posts have a modified gingerbread trim.


