DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This plain two story L-shaped house is on the south side of AliceAnne Street at #123, in the Town of Bel Air, Harford County, Maryland. Covered in asphalt shingle with asphalt shingle gable roofs meeting at right angles where the ell meets the main block, this single stack house has a shed roofed porch shading the first story in front. It is slightly larger and has a bit more decoration than 119 next door to the east. It has turned stock posts supporting the porch roof and carved brackets occupy the angle between the porch posts and the shed roof. The entry is in the center of the three front bays. The windows are 6/6 double-hung sash. Unlike 119, 123 has a small porch on the west side of the ell. There are two rooms, up and down, in the main block; the ell has one room up and down.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This is one of the tenements John G. Rouse built on AliceAnne Street in the last decade of the nineteenth century. Unlike some of the others 123 seems to have been owner occupied for most of its life. It is rental property today.

This house is a little larger than many of the houses on AliceAnne Street; it has a little decoration on it. It is in no way remarkable except as an example of the kind of speculative housing built in Bel Air for the black community.


