DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two and a half story house with a front gable is at 200 S. Bond Street in the Town of Bel Air, Harford County, Maryland. It is aluminum sided. A round headed 2/2 window occupies the front gable (east). The gable roofed main block is three bays wide. The ell (north bays of the west elevation) is two bays wide and has a gable roof at right angles to the main block. The windows are 2/2 double-hung sash except for those in the first story front which are 2/4 with wooden louvered shutters. The front porch has a hip roof carried on slender doric columns. The entrance is in the north bay of the east elevation, a 2 panel over 2 panel door topped by a single pane transom. There is an enclosed single story shed roof porch on the south elevation of the ell. The south inside end chimney has a corbelled cap.

SPECIFIC DATES 1883 BUILDER/ARCHITECT

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This handsome little house on Bond Street at the foot of West Churchville Road was built by James Frank Farley in 1883 on land purchased from Miss Jessie Frazier for \$400 (46/307). He must have been related to the J. E. Farley who was a partner in the John E. Lingan Construction Company (1884) and the John R. Farley who had the harness shop north of the Bel Air Times on Bond Street (1884). In 1886 when he sold the house to Elijah Kirk for \$1450 (56/200), he was living in Baltimore City.

The Kirks had the house for 37 years. The heirs of Elijah Kirk sold it to Simon Getz in 1923 for \$2600 (183/154). Getz mortgaged it that year and lost it in 1926 when it was sold to Jesse and Susan Carr for \$2925 (195/483). Jesse Carr's heirs sold it to Ruth Foard, the present owner, in 1952 (382/235).





