DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two and a half story asphalt shingled double house is at 205 Franklin in the Town of Bel Air, Harford County, Maryland. The north two bays are the original portion of the house. It is probably contemporary with the shot-gun style houses being built on Thomas Street and elsewhere in the Hays Addition between 1875 and 1900.

It has two gable roof lines: the northern two bays have a gable in front and the post 1930 addition has a roof at right angles to that one, with its gable to the south. The windows are flat-arched 2/2 double-hung sash, even those in the gables. The shed roofed front (west) porch is supported on stock turned posts and have scroll brackets. The balusters are plain and square. The original portion of the house has a shed roofed single story kitchen addition to the rear (east). The two entrances are in the middle bays of the front elevation. There are no transoms, just glass over panel doors.

In 1920 it was owned by Clara Robinson. At that time the dwelling was assessed at \$756. It is now a rental unit owned by Carollee Getz.




