DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small survey stone is in the south curb of Office Street nearly to Bond Street in the Town of Bel Air, Harford County, Maryland. It is the northwest stone marking the boundry of the county lot and is one of two remaining. The curb must have been built around it. It has been hit so many times that it is nearly level with the curb. It is painted yellow in a probably futile attempt to prevent further damage to it.

It measures 3'6" in circumference and is 7" tall at its highest point.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Survey Stone #1, one of four stones that were one at each corner of the county lot in the Town of Bel Air, is the northernmost of the two remaining stones. Survey stone #2 is set in the sidewalk against the foundation of 33 Courtland near Bond Street. (More probably 33 Courtland was built up against the stone). The two easterly stones have disappeared under the black top of the parking lots behind the County Building and Courtland Hardware. These stones have been used as surveyor's bench marks since 1782 when the Town was laid out.




MAP: (Indicate North In Circle)


