This small, two-bay, two-story shot-gun house is at 125 Thomas Street in the Town of Bel Air, Harford County, Maryland. Now covered in asphalt shingle, it presents its gable end to the street. The windows are 1/1 double-hung sash. The entrance is in the east bay of the enclosed porch. A shed addition to the rear probably contains the kitchen.

The house is in poor condition and in an expanding commercial area.
