DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This former shot-gun style house, now a commercial establishment, is at 143 Thomas Street in the Town of Bel Air, Harford County, Maryland. A view of its former style can be seen in the narrow gable roof and the asphalt shingled second story. The old windows are 6/6 double-hung sash in thin surrounds.

The first story has been extended to the east and faced in brick. Bow windows flank the entry giving an incongruous colonial arc to this sturdy Victorian. A three bay ell (single story) juts out in the 2 southern bays of the west elevation.
