The property was most recently observed and photographed on January 17, 2003. Its condition appeared to be unchanged since the preparation of the Inventory Form for State Historic Sites Survey form in the library of the Maryland Historical Trust.

The property is described in the Maryland Historical Trust Inventory Form For State Historic Sites Survey prepared by Natalie Shivers, Harford County Historical District Commission, in March 1980. Following is a brief summary of that property description, as modified by site observations made January 17, 2003.

From the description, the house is a two story, gabled roofed (east to west), wood siding, which is three bays wide and one room deep with a center chimney. The building is set on a parged stone foundation. The main wood-framed portico entrance is located at the center bay and is column supported with a lower single-slope shed

roof. Fenestration is typically 6/6 sash windows on the first floor and 3/6 sash windows on the upper floor. In addition, the house was originally described as being in fair condition and altered. It was observed that this property appears unchanged from the description in the attached form.

The property is not associated with any event or personage that would qualify it for eligibility under Criteria A or B, respectively. Although the structure apparently dates from the early Nineteenth Century and was moved to its present location early in the Twentieth, with later additions added, it is architecturally undistinguished and appears from the exterior not to have been well-maintained. The property is not considered to be eligible for registration under the terms of Criterion C: Design/Construction. No known archaeological significance is associated with the property, making it ineligible for consideration under Criterion D.




SUMMARY

The Greenland-Swanner House was moved to this location around 1908 by Winfield B. Greenland. Previously, it had served as a tenant house on the farm of Richard E. Greenland and was located several miles north of its present site. Of indeterminate vintage, the house may have been built by Elisha Greenland who owned the farm from 1814 until 1882.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story, gable-roofed frame house covered in asphalt shingles is located on the north side of Churchville Road west of Stepney Road.

Set on a low stuccoed stone foundation, the house faces south and is three bays wide and one room deep with a one-story addition on the north side. It has a center brick chimney and a boxed cornice with gable returns. Windows have narrow beaded trim and 6/6 sash in the first story and 3/6 sash in the second story. The entrance is located in the center bay of the south side.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

According to Nellie Swanner, current resident and descendent of Elisha Greenland, who owned this property from 1814 until 1882, the Greenland-Swanner House was moved to this location when her father, Winfield B. Greenland, inherited the 120-acre farm in 1908.¹ Winfield Greenland's uncle, Richard E. Greenland, left the farm he had purchased from Elisha Greenland's heirs in 1882² to his two nephews, Winfield Greenland and James Howard Wakeland. According to Nellie Swanner, Richard Greenland lived in the house that now belongs to the Maloys (remodeled drastically) north of this one, and this house was a tenant house farther back in the woods. It may have been built by Elisha Greenland who purchased various parcels--15 acres from Isaac Webster for \$120 in 1825,³ 68 acres from Christian Hgopman for \$500 in 1824,⁴ and 40 acres for \$200 in 1814 from Benjamin Culver.⁵ The \$5000 pricetag for the farm in 1882 indicates that Elisha Greenland made substantial improvements. The 1858 & 1878 maps indicate a Mrs. Greenland in this location.

The configuration and details of the house are of indeterminate vintage--any time from the 2nd quarter of the 19th century on. Still, the Greenlands were a prominent family of farmers in this area, owning a large amount of land, and their houses (see Baker-Greenland House) are representative of the tastes of the agricultural sector of Harford County's population.


