This 2-story clapboard house was constructed in the mid-to-late 19th century by William Hawkins or Albert T. Hawkins. The 1858 and 1878 maps show a structure belonging to Wm. Hawkins in or near this location, although interior detailing suggests a post-Civil War re-modelling, if not actual construction date.

This 45-acre farm, part of the tract "Aquillas Inheritance", has been purchased by Harford Investors Corporation for possible use as an industrial air park. The house and farm buildings will probably be demolished in the near future.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This soon-to-be-demolished 2-story frame clapboard house with newer 1-story shed-roofed additions on the west and south sides is located on the south side of Level Road (Md. Rt. 155) and faces north.

The house is 3 bays wide and 1 room deep with a boxed cornice with gable returns and with an interior brick chimney in the west end. A 1-story shed-roofed porch spans the north facade, which has a center entrance. Windows appear to have had 6/6 sash and plain trim. The fenestration of this facade is slightly off balance with the window and door in the center bay closer to the windows in the western bay than those in the east. While the west end and south side have been covered with plywood, the clapboards on the north side and east end are intact. They are circular sawn with 7-1/2-8 inches exposed.

The interior contains 2 rooms, with the entrance in the west room. The fireplace in the west wall is missing its mantel, and there is a winder stair case in the north-west corner. The attic has hewn joists, although the rafters are sawn and butted together.

West of the house are a frame gambrel-roofed barn and a frame shed. The barn, measuring 32' X 48' set on a rubblestone foundation, has circular-sawn framing and a knee truss supporting the roof. The ground level was used for cattle apparently.

The shed has hewn joists and full log rafters butted together.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This 2-story clapboard house probably dates from the mid-19th century, when it was owned by William Hawkins. The interior woodwork, roof framing, and presence of only one interior fireplace suggests a late 19th century re-modelling - if not an actual construction date. The possibility that the house was constructed by Albert T. Hawkins should not be discounted.

In 1847, Wm. Hawkins was willed by his father, Robert Hawkins, the 45-acre farm where his brother, John Hawkins lived, while John was given the farm where Robert Hawkins had lived "with the reserve of firewood ... and 800 chestnut rails" from John's own farm.¹ Both the 1858 Jennings & Herrick Map and the 1878 Martenet's Map show a structure belonging to William Hawkins in or near this location. And the 1877 State Gazette and Merchants and Farmers Directory lists a William Hawkins in the vicinity of Havre de Grace as a farmer.

In 1888, William Hawkins sold to William H. and Albert T. Hawkins "the farm on which I now reside."² Eight years later William A. sold his half interest³ in the farm, still 45 acres of the tract "Aquillas Inheritance", to Albert T. Hawkins.³ The farm buildings may date from his tenure, which lasted until 1914, when the farm was sold to Charles F. and Oleita B. Bonn.⁴


