DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The frame house at 3228 Churchville Road is a 2-1/2 story structure with a shed roofed porch and hip main roof dating from the early 20th century and located on the east side of Churchville Road (MD 22) about 1/2 mile south of Aldino Road (MD 156).

The house is basically square in plan, with the porch extending across the main elevation and parts of the side elevations. A single dormer with paired windows is centered in the roof of the main elevation. The fenestration is varied and has probably been altered. The 2-bay main elevation is irregular, with the entrance bay completed by a small 1/1 window on the second floor. The other bay is also unequal, with a larger window on the first floor than on the second. The north elevation also has two bays, with the west bay containing paired windows on both floors.

The exterior is asbestos shingle siding and the roof is composition material. A single chimney projects from the roof at the rear of the house.

Several small outbuildings or barns are located at the rear of the house, including a deteriorated frame barn. The apparent 19th century date of this building may indicate the present main house replaced an earlier building.


