DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Smith-Blair House is a late 19th century, two-story house with a gable roof and a one-story porch which is located on the west side of Churchville Road (MD 22) about 300 yards south of Aldino Road.

The exterior of the house is covered with a smooth aggregate concrete and may cover a stone structure. Several outbuildings of frame construction are located behind the house to the west.

Further observation and photography were impossible because of the owner's objection to the survey of the house.


