DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Everett House is a two-story frame house with gable roof and one-story porch dating from the mid-19th century and located on the east side of Churchville Road (MD 22) about 150 yards south of Aldino Road.

The house is a three-bay, center entry plan structure on a stone foundation. A two-story ell projects from the rear and a shed addition, probably built in the 20th century, is attached to the eastern end of the ell. The main section has interior end chimneys and a composition roof. The original clapboards are covered with aluminum siding. The porch has turned columns and scroll sawn brackets.

There are several outbuildings east of the house: a board and batten barn and a concrete and frame barn are the largest buildings. Several smaller frame buildings are located nearby.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Everett House is a good example of a mid-19th century vernacular farmhouse with associated outbuildings forming an agricultural complex. Although the house has been altered and some of the outbuildings are of recent construction, the complex has the appearance of a typical 19th century group.

The house may have been built by a member of the Everett (or Everist) family, who were long-time residents of the area around the intersection of Churchville and Aldino Roads. In the early 20th century, the Everetts operated a vegetable cannery on the farm.


