STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

A two-story frame home with attic on stone foundation. Cross gable roof with bracketed eaves. Double entrance. Four bays wide on the first story, three bays wide on the second story; two bays deep.

Regular fenestration; 6/6 sash windows. Cross gable vented by round arch casement window. Shed roof porch, square columns and scroll work. Extensions on South with third story gable roof.

Building believed to have been erected in the period 1893-95.


