STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The three houses on Holloways Lane appear to be the same three houses that are now listed as 7, 103 and 109 and also shown on map of 1799. The history of the three houses has not been fully researched. Before his death, Harry B. James said that these three houses were the oldest in Aberdeen. His statement could be correct for at that time Aberdeen had not extended its boundaries from the original survey made in 1897. These three houses, like others mentioned, have changed their appearance over the years (page 9, "History of Aberdeen", Richard F. Cronin, 1976)

7 Holloway Lane is a two-story L-Plan house on stone with asphalt brick shingle siding and end chimney. South projection - 1½ story with shed extension.
