7 May 1968, deed Land Records Liber 777, Folio 68, John A. Staples, Jr. conveyed to Betty A. Gompers (daughter) and Wm. R. Gompers, Sr. (her husband) that land described and conveyed by Bennett and Harriett M. Osborn to Wm. E. Jackson by deed dated Sept. 2, 1867 and recorded Liber 19, Folio 142 dated Sept. 2, 1867.

9 Sept. 1867 Liber 19, Folio 142 records a division of property by Wm. E. Jackson grant unto Bennett Osborn that tract of land called "Halls Park" as further described as to location (109 Holloway Lane) $\frac{1}{2}$ acre by this entry.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The three houses on Holloways Lane appear to be the same three houses that are now listed as 7, 103, and 109 and also shown on map of 1799. The history of the three houses has not been fully recorded. Before his death, Harry B. James said that these three houses were the oldest in Aberdeen. His statement could be correct for at that time, Aberdeen had not extended its boundaries from the original survey made in 1897. These three houses, like others mentioned, have changed their appearance over the years (page 9, "History of Aberdeen" by Richard F. Cronin, 1976).

109 Holloway Lane is a 1½ story I-frame house with asphalt brick siding, gable roof, central chimney and irregular fenestration. It is quite likely that that house was built in 1865-67.
