Liber 882, Folio 53-16 Sept. 1971 Robert L. Tarring (estate of John G. Tarring) conveyed the right, title and interest to Leonard E. McGrady and his wife, Goldie S. McGrady (lot No. 9, block 2, 50 ft. frontage on Rogers St. and extended back at even depth 190 ft. to Church Alley.

Liber 687, Folio 212-dated Aug. 28, 1965 Hilda M. Clendenning (widow) to John G. Tarring and Bertha I. Tarring, his wife.

Liber W.S.F No.88, Folio 499-20 June 1918 Aberdeen Land Improvement Co. deeded said land and premises to Hilda M. Clendenning.

Liber 160, Folio 233-Aug. 1, 1918 (deed dated 20 June 1918) records deed to above lands and building from Markowitz Berman and wife to Howard A. Clendenning (deceased) and Hilda M. Clendenning (wife). Cora D. Reasin deeded same land and buildings to Markowitz Berman.

Liber 160, Folio 11-dated 8 Apr. 1918, Cora B. Reasin (widow of Wm. H. Reasin) to Markowitz Berman (Liber 88/Folio 999).

Liber 117, Folio 967-June 29, 1906, Aberdeen Land Improvement Co. Lots 9, 10, 11 and 12 on Block 2 to Henry Tarring (Lot 9, Block 2, 12 S. Rogers) Lots 10, 11, and 12 now belong to John Landbeck).

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Two-story frame and shingle house, 3 bays wide by 3 bays deep with an extension to the West (rear), fieldstone foundation, cross gable on South side has another gable attached and has fishscale shingles and a 1/1 sash window, other windows being 2/2 sash windows.

Porch on East features ornamental brackets and pediment in front of entrance bay, transome over the door, pendants on the corners.

Building believed to have been built in 1890's.
