The series of L-Plan homes on Law St. serve as a visual document of not only Aberdeen's past history but also of how buildings materials have evolved.

This house was formerly on L-Plan similar to 214 Law St. with facade facing East on Law St. 210 Law is a two-story frame and clapboard. The projection to the North is 2 bays wide by 1 bay deep. Projection to the East is 1 bay wide by 2 bays deep. The foundation of the building is fieldstone which is occasionally covered with cement. The building has intersecting gable end roof and a two-story shed roof extension to the West.

The fenestration has been altered to 1 over 1 sash. The entrance door is in the ell of the L facing West.
