STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Formerly an L-plan similar to 214 Law St. with facade facing west on Law St., 211 is a 2-story frame and shingle, 2 bays wide by 1 bay deep, with a projection to the west which is 1 bay wide by 2 bays deep. The projection to the north is 1 bay wide by 2 bays deep. Addition to east is an enclosed porch on the first story and an open porch on the second story. A wrap-around porch is enclosed in the saw-tooth siding, broken shed roof is present on the north and west facades, tongue and groove floor on porch, and exposed rafter ends.

On the west facade, the north bay is blind on the second story and there is an entrance door on the first story. The south bay has a centrally located 2 over 2 sash window on the second story and a centrally located 1 over 1 sash window on the first story.

On the north facade, the west bay has a 2 over 2 sash on the second story and blind on the first story. The central bay has a pair of 1 over 1 sash on the second story, and a 1 over 1 sash on the first story. The east bay has a 1 over 1 sash on the second story and two 1 over 1 sash on the first story.

The east facade is dominated by a full two-story porch.

The south facade has on the west bay, a 2 over 2 sash on the second story and a 1 over 1 sash on the first story.

On the south facade, the central bay has a 2 over 2 sash on the second story, the east bay has a 1 over 1 sash on the second story.

Located centrally to the south bay on first story is an enclosed shed roof porch with entrance.

House erected about 1897.
