DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Henry Harlan House is a two-story stone and concrete block house in which the stone section was possibly built in the second quarter of the 19th century and which is located on the east side of Stafford Road north of the Ellis J. Tucker House (HA-183). Both houses are located on the same large horse farm within sight of each other, but at a distance of about 1/4 mile across open pasture land. The Harlan House original main elevation faced south; the present orientation is north and west.

The original main elevation probably had a three-bay arrangement with an off-center entry. The entry was possibly in the west bay, which now has a window smaller than the others on this elevation. There is also evidence of infill below the window. The other windows on the ground floor are tall and narrow with 2/2 sash and plain architraves. The second floor windows are smaller 6/6 sash. The north elevation has two bays with the west bay containing smaller windows on a lower plane than those of the east bay. The west elevation has the present entrance, a single door under a modern shed proch. The only windows on this elevation are two small square openings at the attic level. A stone one story wing with a concrete block extension adjoin the east gable end. The east end of both the main section and the wing contain interior end brick chimneys. The roof is composition.

North of the house is a stone shop building with an upper floor reached via an outside stair. Local tradition states this was a schoolroom. Other uses may include slave quarters, an office, and a blacksmith shop. The building has a central chimney and a slate roof. The roof extends at the west end to shelter the second floor entrance. A similar building may be found at Box Hill (HA-894).

About 50 yards west of the house is a stone bank barn with a date-stone set in the south gable reading "1819". Metal ventilators break the slate roof and a frame extension has been added to the northwest corner.

The date of 1819 on the barn suggests the entire complex may have been built about that period. The Harlan House was one of those mentioned in W. S. Forwood's "Homes on Deer Creek" series in the 1879-1880 Aegis - Intelligencer. "His (Henry S. Harlan's) buildings are comfortable, but remain in the same condition as they were left by his immediate ancestors; showing his regard for the old style."

Their old stone house is remarkable for its setting on the crest of the river hills.

A small field stone farmhouse, 2 stories, ~~with a 1 story addition~~, ~~with a 1 story addition~~, ~~with a 1 story addition~~, the ridge line runs East West. The south facade of the main house has three windows of uneven sizes, the north facade two windows, of uneven placement suggesting varying floor levels? Entrance to the main house is west, in the end wall. There are no second story windows in this west wall. A one story wing has a door to the north, and the two windows on either side of this door are uneven in size and placement too.

Chimneys in the east wall of each part of the house rise from heating and cooking fireplaces.

Granite building - 1 story, ridgepole running east-west, a central chimney divides two spaces, the east side having wide doors entering onto a space useable as a blacksmith shop with a small forge fireplace and anvil still in situ. The west end may have been tenant housing, but has been used for a tool house in recent decades. Outside steps lead up the west wall to a sheltered doorway.

Very stout construction survives the present neglect so far.







Martinet's Map of Harford County, 1878


