Based upon the information provided, the two-story frame dwelling located off of Pouska Road in Abingdon, Harford County, MD, is not eligible for the National Register. Built in the late 19th-century, the two-story, two-bay frame structure is typical of the rural domestic building of the period and lacks the distinctiveness of type, period or method of construction to make it eligible for the National Register under Criterion C. Further, the property is not known to have been associated with persons or events significant to our past, or to have the potential to yield information important in prehistory or history, and thus is not eligible under Criteria A, B or D.




