Based on the available information, 718 Revolution Street, located in Havre De Grace, does not meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing. The frame, one-and-a-half story hip roofed cottage is a relatively unaltered example of a form of working class housing popular in the early decades of the twentieth century and found throughout Maryland. This house does not appear to possess any particular significance under criterion C. It is not known to have been associated with any significant event or person. It is located two blocks west of the Havre De Grace Historic District and is not within any known historic district.


