The single-family dwelling located at 2024 Singer Road, near Joppa in Harford County, MD, is not located in a National Register Historic District and is not eligible for individual listing on the National Register.

This dwelling is a two-story frame structure covered with a front gable roof. Probably built in the first quarter of the 20th century, the house has been altered in recent years by the replacement of exterior materials and windows. The facade, located in the gable end, is two bays wide with a side entry door; the side walls extend three bays deep. The dwelling is covered with contemporary siding and roofing material and features replacement windows. This dwelling is not an especially good example of front gable dwellings--a fairly common domestic building form from the period--and thus does not qualify for listing on the National Register under Criterion C. The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past and thus does not qualify for listing under Criteria A or B.




CONSTANT FRIENDSHIP BUS PK
