Based on available information the structures at 237 Wilson St., Havre de Grace, MD., are not located within the boundaries of a state listed historic district and do not meet the criteria for individual listing on the Maryland Register. This multi-family housing complex includes four, frame, end gable structures with single story end wings to either side of a 2-story central block. Constructed in 1943 to house overflow military personnel from the Aberdeen Proving Ground the complex was, and is, known as Concord Fields. The buildings are currently used as low income housing. The structures represent no significant development within the history of architecture or planning and lack the architectural distinction to qualify for listing under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons significant to our past, and thus does not qualify under Criterion B. The structures importance as housing associated with WWII is not of sufficient significance to warrant individual listing under Criterion A.


