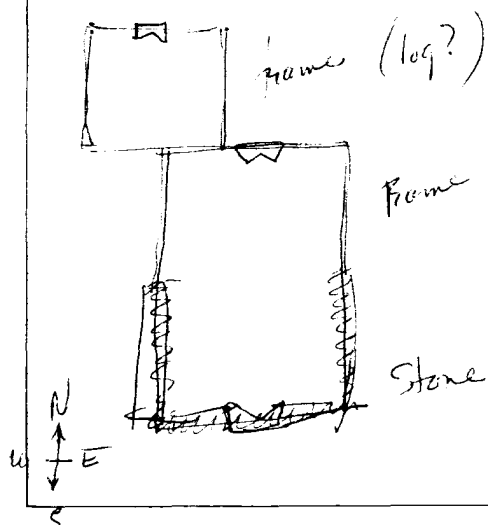

A two story house facing east, the stone part ^{to the south} is under the same slate roofline as the frame part of the main house, and there is a frame wing offset from the north end of the house. The main house appears to be late 18th ~~th~~ up to mid 19th century. Three chimneys are at the ends of the main house and the north end of the small wing.
