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DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Tanbark Hill Site on Graveyard Branch is an unexcavated site located about one half mile upstream from the junction of the stream at Deer Creek. It is about 150 yards southeast of the Holdaway residence at 1831 Deth's Ford Road on the Proctor farm property near Darlington in Harford County, Maryland.

The site consists of the filled-in bed of a millrace on the hillside east of the Branch running in a general north-south direction and terminating at a semi-circular incline in which the tanning vats were apparently located. A small opening at the foot of the millrace was probably the intake for the mill wheel. The cave-like area is said by local residents to be a large stone-walled area in which the wheel stood. The hole was not explored during this survey.

At the foot of the incline are several stones which appear to have been rough cut from a quarry but are now scattered and reveal no particular pattern or structure.

The 1970 survey of this site included mention of the site of a mill pond and timber crib dam with iron spikes located east of the Proctor-Coale House or Wakefield Farm (HA-289). This site was not observed during the current survey.




