DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Price-Garono House is a two story stone house built about 1860 and located on the east side of Deth's Ford Road about one-half mile north of Deer Creek in the vicinity of Darlington, Harford County, Maryland. The main elevation faces north.

The main elevation has five bays and a central entrance under a one story shed porch. A central gable dominates the entrance bay. This gable has a round quadripartite window with scalloped trim. The windows are 6/6 with stone lintels and are flanked by louvered shutters. The porch extends over the central three bays and is supported on chamfered posts with plain brackets. The porch cornice has a modified modillion molding. The composition roof has wide eaves with exposed rafter ends. The chimneys are on the gable ends of the house and are positioned on the interior walls. A one story addition is located on the east end of the main stone section. This addition is apparently frame structured and is currently covered with asbestos shingles. A garage extension connects the addition with a stone outbuilding which may have originally been a freestanding dairy or other service structure for the main house.

A stone smokehouse is located about 50 feet northeast of the house. The upper section of the building is frame with board and batten siding. The roof is wood shingles. Double doors open on the west end of the structure. A large frame barn with board and batten siding is located about 200 feet southeast of the house. The roof is metal sheets. Several other 20th century frame outbuildings are clustered around the barn, primarily on its east side. A small one and one-half story tenant house is the easternmost building of the outbuilding cluster. This house has a formstone exterior.

Granite farmhouse, 2 1/2 stories, 5 bays x 2. The front door is north but the house "faces" the view across the lawn to the Deer Creek hills.

The house plan is two rooms on either side of a hall that runs from entrance to the south porch. Heating fireplaces in the end walls upstairs and down, have chimneys at each end of the house, brick. The ridge line runs east-west. Cornices are wide, corbelled, under the slate roof. A gable is in the south roof of the house, central, has a small rose window.








