DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Frank J. Hopkins House is a two story frame house built about 1868 and located on the south side of Trappe Church Road about one-tenth of a mile west of the intersection of Deth's Ford Road near Darlington, Harford County, Maryland. The main elevation faces east.

The house has a center hall double pile plan with a central gable on the main elevation. The gable has a single round arched window. A one story porch with Tuscan columns extends across the facade and on the north elevation. A two story polygonal bay is located on the south elevation. The interior end chimneys are brick. The main entrance projects out onto the porch in a three-sided bay. The windows are 6/6 and have louvered shutters.

The rear wing projects west from the main section and has been substantially altered with additions on the south elevation. The foundation is stone and the roof is composition material. The original siding was probably clapboard, but is now covered with yellow aluminum siding.






