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### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story, brick house is located on the Merryman Farm in Whiteford. The house overlooks Dooley Road although access is gained from an entrance on Whiteford Road.

This el shaped structure is in extremely poor condition-two bays of the brick el have collapsed and a frame addition is in ruins. The main unit is five bays by two and faces south. The principal facade is of Flemish Bond brick, while the other three sides are of common bond. It has a brick step cornice, flat arches and a lighted basement. Foundations in this house are rubblestone. The principal entrance is in the center bay of the south facade. Its door is of moulded panels. A transom is overhead, the panes of glass have been knocked out. A one story porch, built onto stone foundations had been present on this facade. Only the foundations remain. Window sashes are no longer present in this building. The deep set windows and doors still have moulded panel framing. The gable flank roof is slate covered and had had a brick chimney at each inside end. These have crumbled. The fireplace supports are visible in the cellar-a plain one on the west and a semi-elliptical brick arch, approximately 5.5 feet high on the east. Log beams also visible in the basement. Inside, the house had a through hall with a frame addition at the north end. Walls are plastered. All of the first elevation rooms have beaded chair-rails.

Dr. Merryman showed us a photograph of the house, taken in the 1890's. The house had been painted white. It had had louvered shutters and the windows were six lights over six. Two windows on the south side had been made into one bay window. Chimneys were corbeled brick.

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## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The property on which this hopelessly deteriorated dwelling stands is called Bachelors Addition. In the most recent part, this home was known as a Whiteford residence, the Whiteford family having owned this property from 1838 until 1963. Nathaniel Wiley, owner of this land in 1793 is listed in the 1798 Federal Tax List as owning 100 acres in Broad Creek Hundred. The house on that property is described as a one story dwelling, however.


