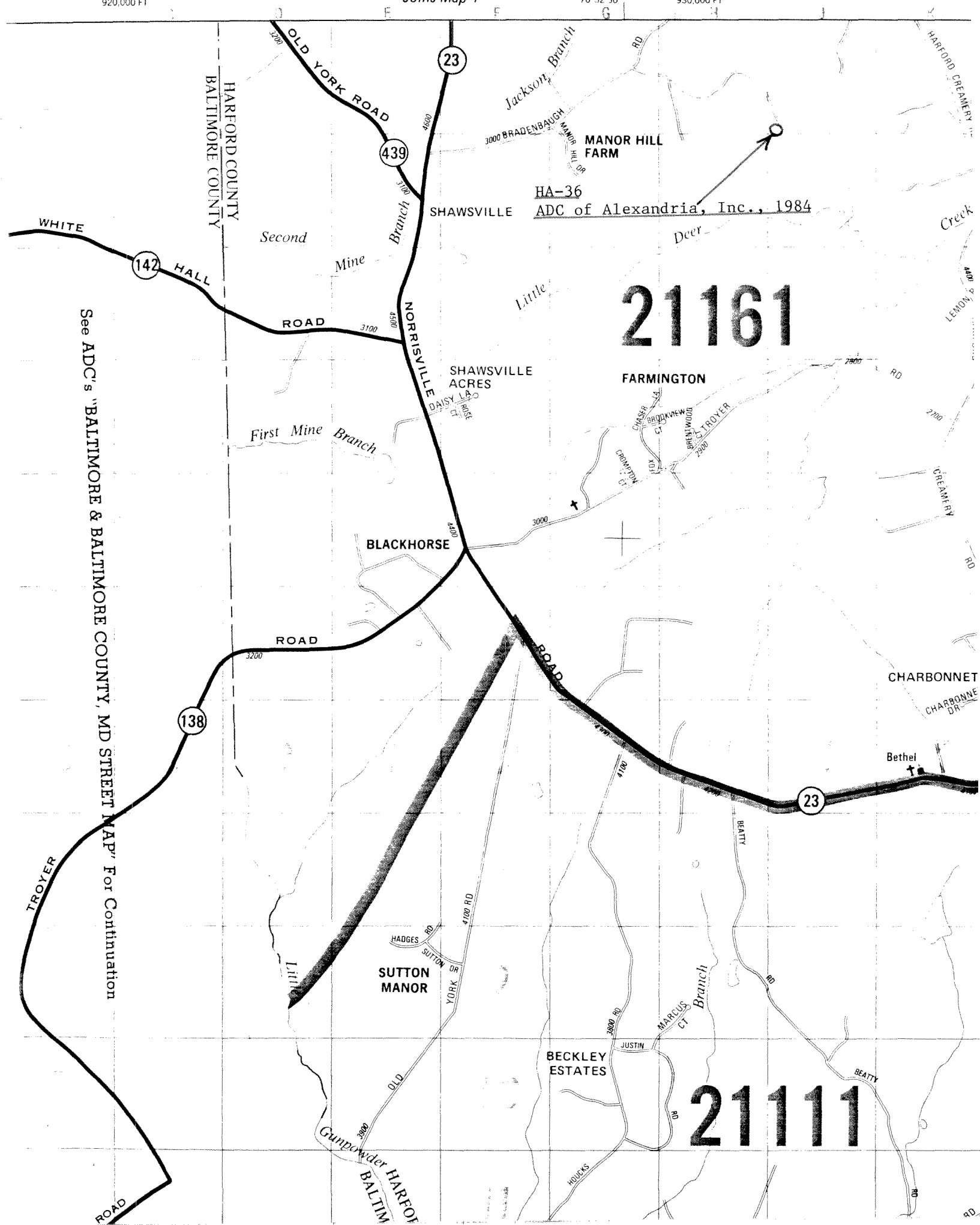
Long one-story porch across ~~main~~ ^{three} bays of main section of house, ~~where the wall is stucco~~. where the wall is stucco.
