## Exterior

This dwelling is a c. 1870's stone house that has received multiple frame additions in this century. The original building is a two story stone structure that faces West. Its walls are made of fieldstone with large cut stone quoins and it is capped with a slate gable-end roof. The fenestration is regular utilizing all 2/2 sash. The original house is 3 bays wide and two deep.

Interior end chimneys with uncorbeled brick caps and the centrally located entrance suggest the fact that this is a center hall plan consisting of the hall itself and flanking parlours. There were five fireplaces and all the mantels of which are stored in the barn.

## Interior

There is strong evidence that the basement of this house contained the kitchen. There is a large fireplace on the East end of the room. While the chimney piece is gone the crane remains. It is a 49" high by 47" wide opening in a chimney with 7' breast and 23" depth. The entire chimney was plastered and painted as was the rest of the room.

The ceilings were left exposed exhibiting 3" X 9" vertically sawn joists. The floorboards of the upper level are 8'9" above the cellar floor.

The main level is divided into two parlours on either side of a center hall. Each room had its own fireplace. The hall has entrances at both ends and like other doorways in the house these are finished with sunken-panel reveals. It is only 6' wide and contains an open dogleg stairs that is 3' wide. This is an open stairs with turned balusters and a dark (walnut?) hand rail. A window in the North wall lighted the landing prior to its being closed off.

The second floor and finished attic reflect the plan below i.e. a hall with a room on either side. the attic rooms are typified by their trapezoidal tray ceilings and knee-walls. The roof framing is unexposed.

## Outbuildings

Approximately 40 yards East of the house are a modern bank barn and corn crib. Both buildings utilize such materials as circular sawn lumber nailed with wire nails and concrete foundation.

The springhouse, however, appears to be of the same vintage as the dwelling. It is constructed of like stone and utilizes a common plan. Its ridge is 17'4" long and the building is 10' wide and straddles a spring stream. The roof is a replacement and incorporates a 5' overhang on the north end. A 24" X 14" window vents the west side and a centrally located door is in the north wall. The overhang covers a sunken area and the spring opening itself is in the north wall of the enclosure.




