DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The John W. Coale House is a two story, three part stone and frame vernacular house built about 1840 to 1850 and located on the west side of Glenville Road south of Deer Creek near Glenville in Harford County, Maryland. The house is set back from the road and screened by woods at the end of an access road. The main elevation faces southeast.

The house's three parts are arranged end-to-end in a telescoping manner. The largest section, the southernmost, has a three bay southeast elevation. The northern bay containing the entrance is frame. Above the second floor windows, there is evidence that the roofline has been raised in that the stone is in smaller blocks and the mortar joints more prominent than in the lower part. An interior chimney is located in the south gable end of the stone section. A diamond shaped tie rod end plate at the second floor level is visible on both the southeast and northwest elevations.

The two frame sections were added in 1937 by a previous owner. The windows in all sections are mostly 6/6, but a modern bay window has been added to the first floor level of the center frame section, and a multi-paned picture window to the northern section. A shed porch extends across the southeast elevation.

The roof of all three sections is slate. A single dormer with paired windows breaks the roof on the stone section.

At the rear of the house about 40 feet from the south end of the stone section is a stone chimney stack. According to the owner, a log kitchen wing which predated the stone house connected with the stone section at right angles. This wing was torn down in about 1937 by a previous owner and was probably in a deteriorated condition at that time. The remaining chimney has been stabilized.

The stone foundations of a barn are located about 100 feet northwest of the house. A tractor shed has been built along one wall of the foundation.

Facing south, the ridgelines of the A-roofs run east-west. Chimneys rise from heated fireplace inside the end walls, brick.






