The building was remodeled in 1890 by Richard Nicholas Wiley. Wiley is said to have rebuilt the old mill on the old foundations.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This stone and frame structure is located approximately two miles south of Norrisville on Deer Creek. The building faces west.

Ivory Mill is built into the slope of a hill and appears as a three story structure on the west facade and four stories on all other sides. The first two stories of the Mill are of rubble stone.

Fireplaces on the first and second level are located in the southwest corner. A corbeled brick chimney is situated on the southwest corner of the tin roof.

Remaining Window sashes of this large structure are six lights over six. The building has deteriorated considerably over the past twenty-five years. A photograph of Ivory Mill in the The Harford County Directory of 1953 shows a freshly painted structure with all window panes intact.

The barn at Ivory Mill is built of rubble stone and vertical boards. It replaces a larger barn which burned many years ago.

Also on this site is a corncrib (HA-451), a frame carriage house and granary (HA-452), ruins of a springhouse (HA-453), and the site of a covered bridge that at one time spanned Deer Creek (HA-454). Bridge abutments remain.
