DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Stone house, masonry unexcavated except that facing a two-story porch where there is stucco. Oblong, 3 bays by 2, 2 stories over a high bank basement facing south, the porch extends across the basement and first story with a light railing and delicate posts. The slate roof ridge line runs east-west, the datestone near the west chimney reads 1811 (perhaps the date the roof was changed from ^{wood} shingles to slate). On the main floor windows have $\frac{9}{6}$ lights, $\frac{6}{6}$ upstairs and in the south basement wall. Chimneys at each end are fluted, inside.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

C Milton beregler believes this to be the first, or original Wiley house built by Matthew Wiley who came in 1778 from Chester County, Pa., via York, owned 2000 acres in this area, and set up three sons in the milking business, one at this site (HA 448) one about 1 1/2 miles upstream to the west (HA 458) owned later by son Matthew, and one north along a tributary to Deer Creek (HA 40).

By 1878 the Martenet map of Harford County identifies this house as belonging to Asbury Slade.
