DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 2 1/2 story house is brick painted white, four bays by two with a fifth bay added, spaced differently, to the west end of the slate roof whose ridge line runs east-west. Three evenly spaced <sup>hip-roofed</sup> ~~gables~~ <sup>the</sup> dormers, at front of the house face south. A one-story porch runs across the south side.

Chimneys vary in size - a small flush interior chimney is at the east end, a very large interior chimney rises from location of the wall that would have finished off the 4-bay house, inside the addition.

The roof has wide eaves, tin or copper roofing. Windows in the dormers and at the ends are 6/6, elsewhere 2/2.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

It seems that this house may originally have been part the four bay by two section, and that later additions were made to the west end, ~~where~~ the roof changed to wide-eaves under tin or copper roofing, and then dormers added, spaced according to ~~the~~ the new dimensions of the house.

A good simple 18<sup>c</sup> house made more spacious ~~about~~ fifty to a hundred years later.

In 1857 it was ~~set~~ <sup>advertised for</sup> sale as part of the 270 acre property of Samuel Westcott along with Chrome Valley Mill, HA ~~308~~ <sup>309</sup>. On Martine's map of 1878 it is identified as S. Westcott's house.
