Here is the same house plan called the classic Harford County farm house plan in HA 477, 478, much the most prevalent in house plans seen to date, copied for perhaps a hundred and fifty years from 1750 to 1900.

Worth a separate study?

This is a weak example, however pleasant the basic house may be. Tenants occupied, maintained as a purely utilitarian abode for the retiring farmer, provided as part of his wages, a far cry from the old family farm house it began in life.
