DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This rubble stone house is situated on the corner property at Cherry Hill and Grier Nursery Roads. The house is situated at the end of a long, winding lane and faces northwest.

The house consists of two units, each two stories high. Each unit has plain quoins. Large stone lintels are present on the first elevation of each unit. The gable flank roof is covered with slate and has a box cornice. Windows and doors are pegged in both sections.

The main unit is three bays long. The principal entrance is in the center bay of the northwest facade. This entrance has been closed up and is no longer used. Windows on the first and second elevation of this facade are six lights over six. The south west facade is stuccoed on the first elevation. Two doors are present on this side and a one story shed roof porch is also there. Attic windows flank the brick, inside end chimney on this facade. These windows are boarded up. Another brick chimney is located at the opposite end. A seam is visible near the south corner of this facade indicating a two feet extension of the southeast facade. The fenestration of the southeast facade is identical to the northwest side. Windows on the second elevation are three lights over six, however. There is no cellar under this section.

The kitchen unit is two bays long and has 5 brackets on the southeast facade. An exterior entrance to this unit's cellar is located on the southeast side under the window. There is only one window on the northeast facade an attic window near the north corner. It is boarded up. An inside end, brick chimney is on this facade. There is no break in this wall as there is on the southwest side of the main unit. This seems to indicate that the kitchen unit was a late addition and the main unit was expanded at the time of the addition.

Entrance could not be gained to this house because the tenants were suspicious. The owner of the house was very helpful in the drawing of the floor plan, however. The fireplaces in this house have been closed up. The walls are plastered.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Very little is known about the origins of this stone dwelling. Located on the tract, "Crooked Ridge", this house does not match descriptions of dwellings attributed to the Rigdon family in the 1798 Federal Tax List.

Though both Baker and Stephen Rigdon are included in Deer Creek Middle Hundred's list, their homes are described as 1 story, wood structures.

The stone, survey markers from this tracts survey in the early eighteenth century are still intact. One marker bears the initials "T. B. R." for Thomas Baker Rigdon, the owner of the tract until 1797.


