Three-part house - the largest section in the middle. Frame ends and Log centre section covered with clapboard.

The house faces north. The ridgepole runs east-west; all parts are two stories.

The center section is three bays ~~by~~ downstairs, two windows upstairs. Chimneys at either end ~~have~~ similar brick tops - the one on the west is exterior (perhaps once a drumstick ~~chimney~~). The west section has two windows on the north, one upstairs at the end of the house.

The east end has an uneven pattern of windows, 2 downstairs, 1 up, by 1 at the east end. Windows in the ends have 6 lights over 6, in the centre 4 over 4. There is a porch on the north across the first floor of the centre section, one on the south at the east section.
