Facing east, the roof ridge runs north-south, the wing lies west along the north wall.</p> <p>2 stories in the main house, the wing has a small attic window under the eaves (near floor level inside). 4 bays by 2 with 2 x 2 in the wing.</p> <p>The shallow-pitch roofline has wide eaves in the larger section, narrow in the old wing where the pitch is steeper. Inside flush chimneys in the north and west gables rise from fire places, an exterior chimney in the south gable appears to be new.</p>
