DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Shawsville store building is frame, clapboard covered, 2 stories, facing west with the low-pitch roof/ridgeline running east-west. Several additions complicate analysis of the building: perhaps the store was built westward towards the road from a small 2 story house, now the rear of the store.

Facing west, the store has two large windows flanking a double door ~~in a pseudo classical style with~~ four false columns, pseudo classical motif. The gable above has cut-wood finerywork. To the ~~right~~ of this 20' facade is ~~added~~ ^{added about 15' more} space, a long lean-to enclosure ~~along~~ ^{added to} the north side of the building, with no windows downstairs to interfere with shelving inside.

About 40' long, the south wall has three windows upstairs widely spaced in thirty feet, and ^{2 more closely spaced} at the east end. (What may possibly have been a small house, 2 bays x 2, with a chimney rising from the peak about 12' from
