The west section has 3 bays x 2 downstairs, 2 bays x 2 up; the middle section 3 bays by 2, with a lower A ~~roofline~~ roofline and lower ceilings than the west end. The thick section, again two stories, has 2 bays by 2 under a lean-to roof. A one-story porch across the south side is partly enclosed. Windows throughout are 6 lights or 6. There is a large brick-topped chimney at the west end of the west section, and the east end of the middle section. Walls of the middle section are thick and are believed to be of log construction.
