Frame house, ^{clapboard covered,} T shaped, facing west,
 3 bays x 2 plus 2 by 1 in the wing.
 Two storied, the ^{peaked} asphalt roof has wide
 eaves. A high-peaked ~~g~~ gable is centered
~~in~~ the west facade. A one-story porch
 with a shallow portico shelters the west
 door and windows. Windows have 6 lights over 6.
 Three chimneys rise from the three
 gable ends of the house, small brick
 chimneys built for heating and cooking stoves.
 Though the kitchen wing is smaller scale,
 it may pre-date the main house
 by only a few years.
