DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

One-story stone building about 15' x 24'.
 The ~~stone~~ stone walls rise about 5' on all sides; the gable end walls are finished in vertical siding. The roof ridge line was not relocated when the building was widened, hence the varied slope to the A frame roof, the ridge line running east-west. At that time a fireplace was added in the new north wall, west corner.

A door and a window are in each end wall, east and west. The long walls on the north and south sides have three hipped casement windows under the eaves.

Built over the well there were ~~one~~ stone troughs ^{along the top south wall} to hold crocks of milk and other foods to be cooled by well-water pumped from below. The troughs were not moved when the building was enlarged to accommodate the bottling business. Now the ^{new} pump ^{is} in the old location automatically supplies water for the house. Troughs are removed and the building is a toolhouse & workshop.
