DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farm house, L shaped, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ stories, is the conventional 3 bay x 2 house with a peaked gable over the front door, peaked dormer in the wing, 3 bays by 2, the wing in this case the same scale as the front of the house. Facing west, the ridgepole of the A roof runs north-south. There are two chimneys, one inside flush with the north end wall, one in the interior of the wing. Windows have 6 lights over 6, except for two small windows in the end walls lighting the attic, 4 lights over 4. An ornate porch on the west, one storied, shelters the front door, and the windows. The ^{south} side porch in the wing ^(no longer used) is enclosed.
