Frame house with some log walls still under the stucco outside and plaster inside. L Shaped, facing west away from the entry, it is 1 1/2 stories over a dark basement opening to the west, the basement walls made of granite. 3 bays by 1, with the newer wing to the east having 1 bay x 2. There are two inside chimneys flush with the east and north walls. The A roof ridgeties runs north-south, and extends over most of the west wall into a long one-story porch.

Much altered with window enlargements, partition removals, frame additions and added layers of wall covering, it is at present covered with asphalt shingles and stucco.
