STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE The Bakers of Aberdeen, descendants of a colonial era Nicholas Baker, were perhaps the most prominent family in the Aberdeen area in the late nineteenth and early twentieth century. They were leaders in the canning industry, in government, the Methodist Episcopal Church, farming, baking and real estate. They built imposing Victorian residences in Aberdeen and established the local cemetery which bears the family name and contains a number of large monuments to mark their own final resting places. ("The Baker Family of Aberdeen" by Jon Harlan Livezey, Harford Historical Bulletin No. 16)

The lots of Charles W. (this), James B. (453 W. Bel Air Ave) and William B. Baker were purchased in 1893 from the Aberdeen Land and Improvement Co. (Liber WSF 75, Folio 424) and all three houses were built soon thereafter.

The "Charles W. Baker" house is located on the SW corner of W. Bel Air Ave. and Paradise Road. Its multiplaned roof, juxtaposition of shapes and textures and symmetrical lighting arrangement characterize the Queen Anne style of the 19th century. The house rests behind a wrought iron fence with intermittent granite stone posts. The two entrance gates no doubt permitted easy access and egress around the circular drive just east of the house. Once the focal point of a prosperous farm with various outbuildings, this massive residence now dwarfs the two remaining outbuildings located to the north. A third building, a large barn located on the east side of Paradise Road, is believed by the present owner of the Baker house to have been converted to a house many years ago. Though technically a two story house, its hipped roof, wall dormers and gabled end and shed roof extensions allow for a third level living arrangement.

This huge frame mansion, clapboard and shingle covered, has an intricate free floor plan, not bound by symmetry, or the need for small cells to heat by fireplace since the house had central heat. Facing south, a fancy porch shelters the south and east sides, first floor. 2 1/2 stories, the house has Tiffany glass window lights beside the doorways downstairs. The most notable feature of the house, perhaps, is the heavy copper & cocks comb decoration along the ridge line of the roof, running north-south.
