Oblong, it faces east, the slate roof ridge line running north-south. 2 stories, there is a one-story porch on the east side of the house. Windows have 2 lights over 2.

There is a fireplace upstairs and down in the south end of the house.

This small frame house was almost doubled in size in the late 1800's with a cut wood panel in the eaves the only concession to the ornate Victorian style of the day.

Now an apartment for the owner, an apartment for rent and a rooming house for four boarders, it sustains its owner, Mrs. Middleton, a widow.

Similar to about a dozen houses built later along these lines.
