<p>The little clapboard house is of <u>log &amp; frame</u> construction, is being (moved or) demolished by State Roads.</p> <p>In three parts, L shaped, the house faces east, the wrap runs west along the north wall. Windows could not be seen.</p> <p>The larger section A*, 2 stories, 3 bays x 0, has log construction walls, according to Mr. Joseph Siergowski, who has had time to build a modern <del>house</del> house on land behind the house. A chimney rises <del>just</del> inside the south wall. The second story is tucked under low eaves. Ceilings are low. The house measures about 28'6" x 17'.</p> <p>The middle section (B) north end, part, is about 17' square, frame, covered with clapboard. One story, it has no chimney, the roof ridge line runs north-south in these two sections.</p> <p>The third section (C) is a later <del>addition</del> fletcher, 1 bay by 1, the roof ridge line runs east-west.</p>





