This small country store should not be confused with the Chestnut Hill Store and Post Office building, now demolished, which was shown on the 1878 Martenet map. Even very small rural communities often had two or more stores. The cooling troughs in the cellar suggest that the building also served as a springhouse. It is also possible that the store did not operate on a continuous basis and, when not open for business, the building was used for other purposes.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Robinson's Store is a one-story frame building on a partially exposed stone foundation built about 1875 and located on the north side of Deer Creek Church Road about 300 yards north of Deer Creek Methodist Church (HA-874) near Chestnut Hill, Harford County, Maryland. The main elevation faces south. The building is now in a fenced cow pasture about 200 feet from the road.

The raised cellar originally contained troughs for milk cans cooled by a small stream routed through the cellar. The stone walls are deteriorated near the northwest corner so that the cellar interior is partially open. The upper frame structure is also somewhat deteriorated, revealing plaster over lath interior walls. The plain window frames are shuttered. The single door is in the south elevation. The exterior weatherboards were once whitewashed, but are now almost devoid of color. The gable roof is slate.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This small country store should not be confused with the Chestnut Hill Store and Post Office building, now demolished, which was shown on the 1878 Martenet map. Even very small rural communities often had two or more stores. The cooling troughs in the cellar suggest that the building also served as a springhouse. It is also possible that the store did not operate on a continuous basis and, when not open for business, the building was used for other purposes.

Although no definite information is available, Thomas Robinson may have built the store. The main house on the property dates from the early 20th century, but Robinson owned the farm and much of the nearby land during the late 19th century.

NOTE: HA-895 was originally assigned to Box Hill Farmhouse. Information on this building is consolidated with HA-894, Box Hill; Site of Lauretum.


